Because universal fit forklift buckets slip onto the blades directly, they stay on the machinery and are less vulnerable to damage. These buckets are even fifty percent deeper compared to the quick-tach bucket models. This additional room makes them ideal for carrying irregular shaped loads such as elevating roof gravel, moving large debris piles, broken up concrete, backfilling behind walls and tearing off roof trash.
